Plotting:

```
import pylab
```

```
pylab.plot(xValue, yValue, 'bo') to plot a point in blue
```

```
pylab.plot(xValue, yValue, 'ro') to plot a point in red
```

```
pylab.arrow(from_xValue, from_yValue,  
            to_xValue-from_xValue, to_yValue-from_yValue,  
            head_width=.2, head_length=.5) to draw an arrow between two points
```

```
pylab.xlim(minXValue, maxXValue) to set the x-axis range
```

```
pylab.ylim(minYValue, maxYValue) to set the y-axis range
```

```
pylab.axhline(0), pylab.axvline(0) to draw axes
```

```
pylab.show() to display the plot
```
